Lou Sullivan, born Sheila Jean Sullivan, was a pioneering figure in the transgender community. He was the first transgender man to publicly identify as gay and played a crucial role in the development of the FTM movement. Sullivan's activism and advocacy were instrumental in shaping the understanding of sexual orientation and gender identity as distinct concepts. His work included founding FTM International and writing practical guides for transgender individuals seeking gender confirmation and transition.
